- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 621.102, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 621.102. [COMMISSION'S] AUTHORITY TO SET MAXIMUM
- 8 WEIGHTS. (a) The <u>director</u> [commission] may set the maximum single
- 9 axle weight, tandem axle weight, or gross weight of a vehicle, or
- 10 maximum single axle weight, tandem axle weight, or gross weight of a
- 11 combination of vehicles and loads, that may be moved over a state
- 12 highway or a farm or ranch road if the <u>director</u> [commission] finds
- 13 that heavier maximum weight would rapidly deteriorate or destroy
- 14 the road or a bridge or culvert along the road. A maximum weight set
- 15 under this subsection may not exceed the maximum set by statute for
- 16 that weight.
- 17 (b) [The commission must set a maximum weight under this
- 18 section by order entered in its minutes.
- 19  $\left[\frac{(c)}{c}\right]$  The <u>director</u>  $\left[\frac{commission}{commission}\right]$  must make the finding under
- 20 this section on an engineering and traffic investigation and in
- 21 making the finding shall consider the width, condition, and type of
- 22 pavement structures and other circumstances on the road.
- (c)  $[\frac{d}{d}]$  A maximum weight or load set under this section
- 24 becomes effective on a highway or road when appropriate signs

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- 1 giving notice of the maximum weight or load are erected on the
- 2 highway or road [under order of the commission].
- 3 <u>(d)</u> [<del>(e)</del>] A vehicle operating under a permit issued under
- 4 Section 623.011, 623.071, 623.094, 623.121, 623.142, 623.181,
- 5 623.192, or 623.212 may operate under the conditions authorized by
- 6 the permit over a road for which the <u>director</u> [commission] has set a
- 7 maximum weight under this section.
- 8  $\underline{\text{(e)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(f)}}{\text{)}}$ ] For the purpose of this section, a farm or ranch
- 9 road is a state highway that is shown in the records of the
- 10 commission to be a farm-to-market or ranch-to-market road.
- 11  $\underline{\text{(f)}}$  [\frac{(g)}{}] This section does not apply to a vehicle
- 12 delivering groceries, farm products, or liquefied petroleum gas.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
