Section 1403.002(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) As provided by <u>Sections 49-1(a) and (a-1)</u> [Section 8 49-1], Article III, Texas Constitution, the authority shall, in 9 accordance with requests from the office of the governor: 10 11 (1)issue general obligation bonds and notes in an 12 aggregate amount not to exceed \$235 [\$175] million, as authorized by the office of the governor under Subsection (b); and 13

14 (2) as directed by the Texas Department of
15 Transportation, distribute the proceeds from the sale of the bonds
16 and notes to counties to provide financial assistance for colonia
17 access roadway projects to serve border colonias.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the date on which the 19 constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature, Regular 20 Session, 2011, authorizing the issuance of up to \$60 million in 21 general obligation bonds or notes to provide financial assistance 22 to counties for roadway projects to serve colonias is approved by 23 the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the voters, this 24 Act has no effect.
