AN ACT

- 2 relating to financial oversight of junior college districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2102.003(5), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (5) "State agency" means a department, board, bureau,
- 7 institution, commission, or other agency in the executive branch of
- 8 state government. The term includes a junior college district.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2102.009, Government Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 2102.009. ANNUAL REPORT. (a) The internal auditor of
- 12 <u>a state agency other than a junior college district</u> shall prepare an
- 13 annual report and submit the report before November 1 of each year
- 14 to the governor, the Legislative Budget Board, the Sunset Advisory
- 15 Commission, the state auditor, the state agency's governing board,
- 16 and the administrator.
- 17 (b) The internal auditor of a junior college district shall
- 18 prepare an annual report and submit the report before November 1 of
- 19 <u>each year to the state auditor and the Texas Higher Education</u>
- 20 <u>Coordinating Board.</u>
- (c) The state auditor shall prescribe the form and content
- 22 of the annual report, subject to the approval of the legislative
- 23 audit committee.
- SECTION 3. Sections 2102.0091(a) and (c), Government Code,

- 1 are amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) A state agency, other than a junior college district,
- 3 shall file with the Sunset Advisory Commission, the budget division
- 4 of the governor's office, the state auditor, and the Legislative
- 5 Budget Board a copy of each report submitted to the state agency's
- 6 governing board or the administrator of the state agency if the
- 7 state agency does not have a governing board by the agency's
- 8 internal auditor. A junior college district shall file a copy of
- 9 each report submitted to the district's governing board by its
- 10 internal auditor with the state auditor and the Texas Higher
- 11 Education Coordinating Board.
- 12 (c) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (a), a
- 13 state agency, other than a junior college district, shall file with
- 14 the budget division of the governor's office, the state auditor,
- 15 and the Legislative Budget Board any action plan or other response
- 16 issued by the state agency's governing board or the administrator
- 17 of the state agency if the state agency does not have a governing
- 18 board in response to the report of the state agency's internal
- 19 auditor. A junior college district shall file any action plan or
- 20 other response issued by the district's governing board to the
- 21 <u>internal auditor's report with the state auditor and the Texas</u>
- 22 <u>Higher Education Coordinating Board.</u>
- SECTION 4. Section 2102.013, Government Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 25 (d) A junior college district shall submit a copy of the
- 26 written risk assessment to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating
- 27 Board.

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- 1 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 2 beginning with the 2014-2015 fiscal year.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
