- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 51, Property Code, is amended by adding

- 7 Sec. 51.0022. FORECLOSURE DATA COLLECTION. (a) In this
- 8 section, "department" means the Texas Department of Housing and
- 9 Community Affairs.
- 10 (b) A person filing a notice of sale of residential property
- 11 under Section 51.002(b) must submit to the county clerk a completed
- 12 form that provides the zip code for the property.
- (c) On completion of a sale of real property, the trustee or
- 14 sheriff shall submit to the county clerk a completed form that
- 15 contains information on whether the property is residential and the
- 16 zip code of the property.
- 17 (d) Not later than the 30th day after the date of receipt of
- 18 a form under this section, the county clerk shall transmit the form
- 19 to the department.
- 20 <u>(e) The board of the department shall prescribe the forms</u>
- 21 required under this section. The forms may only request
- 22 information on whether the property is residential and the zip code
- 23 of the property.

- 1 under this section quarterly to the legislature in a format
- 2 established by the board of the department by rule.
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) The board of the Texas Department of
- 4 Housing and Community Affairs shall adopt the forms and rules
- 5 required by Section 51.0022, Property Code, as added by this Act,
- 6 not later than January 1, 2012.
- 7 (b) The change in law made by Section 51.0022, Property
- 8 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a notice of sale filed on
- 9 or after January 1, 2012. A notice of sale filed before January 1,
- 10 2012, is governed by the law in effect on the date the notice is
- 11 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
