A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the renewal of a physical therapist or physical

3 therapist assistant license issued by the Texas Board of Physical

4 Therapy Examiners.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Sections 453.252(b) and (c), Occupations Code,

7 are amended to read as follows:

- 8 (b) A person whose license has been expired for 90 days or
- 9 less may renew the license by paying to the executive council the
- 10 renewal fee and a late fee set by the executive council in an amount
- 11 that does not exceed one-half [that is equal to half] of the amount
- 12 charged for examination for the license. If a person's license has
- 13 been expired for more than 90 days but less than one year, the
- 14 person may renew the license by paying to the executive council all
- 15 unpaid renewal fees and a <u>late</u> fee <u>set by the executive council in</u>
- 16 an amount that does not exceed [that is equal to] the amount charged
- 17 for examination for the license.
- 18 (c) A person whose license has been expired for one year or
- 19 longer <u>must comply with the board's requirements and procedures to</u>
- 20 reinstate the license and pay a reinstatement fee in the amount set
- 21 by the executive council [may not renew the license]. If the person
- 22 is unable to comply with the board's requirements to reinstate the
- 23 license, the [The] person may obtain a new license by submitting to
- 24 reexamination and complying with the requirements and procedures

- 1 for obtaining an original license.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 453.253, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 453.253. RENEWAL OF EXPIRED LICENSE BY OUT-OF-STATE
- 5 PRACTITIONER. (a) The board may renew without reexamination the
- 6 expired license of a person who was licensed to practice as a
- 7 physical therapist or physical therapist assistant in this state,
- 8 moved to another state, [and] is currently licensed and in good
- 9 standing [has been in practice] in the other state, and meets the
- 10 board's requirements for renewal [for the two years preceding
- 11 application].
- 12 (b) The person must pay to the executive council a renewal
- 13 fee set by the executive council in an amount that does not exceed
- 14 [that is equal to] the examination fee for the license.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 16 date of this Act, the Texas Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and
- 17 the Executive Council of Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy
- 18 Examiners shall adopt rules and fees necessary to implement
- 19 Sections 453.252 and 453.253, Occupations Code, as amended by this
- 20 Act.
- 21 (b) Sections 453.252 and 453.253, Occupations Code, as
- 22 amended by this Act, apply only to a physical therapist or physical
- 23 therapist assistant license that is renewed on or after the
- 24 effective date of the rules and fees described by Subsection (a) of
- 25 this section, regardless of the date on which the license holder
- 26 submitted the application to renew the license. A license that is
- 27 renewed before the effective date of the rules and fees described by

- 1 Subsection (a) of this section is governed by the law in effect
- 2 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 3 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
