## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the declaration of local disaster. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 418.108(i), Chapter 418, Government 4 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: (i) A declaration under this section may, include a 6 restriction that exceeds a restriction authorized by Section 7 352.051, Local Government Code, if the Keetch-Byram Index level in 8 Section 352.051(a)(2), Local Government Code, is exceeded and the 9 governor has suspended the sale, dispensing, or transportation of 10 the items in Section 418.019 within the county. A restriction that 11 12 exceeds a restriction authorized by Section 352.051(c), local Government Code, is effective only: 13 14 (1) for 60 hours unless extended by the governor; and 15 if the county judge requests the governor to grant (2) an extension of the restriction. 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
