1 (15) "Pool-related electrical device" means equipment for a pool that: 2 3 (A) is installed as a unit; 4 (B) is directly connected to an electrical circuit; [and] 5 6 (C) performs a specific function; and 7 (D) uses single-phase power of 240 volts or less. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11

Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
