H.B. No. 3404

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to establishing a child care advisory committee to advise
3 the Texas Facilities Commission.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 663.051, Government Code, is reenacted
6 and amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 663.051. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) The commission
8 shall appoint a child care advisory committee composed of
9 individuals who are interested in child care services for state
10 employees.

11 (b) The commission may appoint to the committee:

12 (1) the executive directors of:

13 (A) the commission; and

14 (B) the Texas Department of Housing and Community
15 Affairs;

16 (2) two representatives of nonprofit organizations
17 involved with the delivery or support of child care services;

18 (3) ~~[a representative of the corporate child~~
19 ~~development fund,~~

20 ~~[(4)]~~ a representative of child care providers;

21 (4) ~~[(5)]~~ one or more state employees subject to the
22 state classification plan:

23 (A) each of whom has at least one child in a child
24 care facility; and

1 (B) if more than one is appointed, each of whom
2 resides in a different geographic area of the state; and

3 (5) [~~(6)~~] one or more individuals knowledgeable in
4 child care services or the need of working individuals for child
5 care services.

6 (c) The committee shall advise the commission on the:

7 (1) location, size, and design of the child care
8 facilities; and

9 (2) curriculum a child care facility must provide to
10 ensure the provision of developmentally appropriate services of a
11 high quality.

12 (d) The committee is abolished and this section expires
13 September 1, 2021.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
