- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 104, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 104.059 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 104.059. RECOVERY OF RATE PROCEEDING EXPENSES
- 8 PROHIBITED. (a) In establishing a gas utility's rates, the
- 9 regulatory authority may not allow the utility to recover through
- 10 its rates the attorney's fees or other expenses incurred by any
- 11 party in a rate proceeding conducted under this chapter or in an
- 12 appeal of a rate proceeding.
- 13 (b) A court may not award to a party the right to recover
- 14 through a gas utility's rates the attorney's fees or other expenses
- 15 incurred by any party in a rate proceeding conducted under this
- 16 chapter or in an appeal of a rate proceeding.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 104.059,
- 18 Utilities Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a rate
- 19 proceeding for which a statement of intent is filed under Section
- 20 104.102, Utilities Code, or for which a regulatory authority serves
- 21 notice on a gas utility under Section 104.151, Utilities Code, on or
- 22 after the effective date of this Act. A rate proceeding for which a
- 23 statement of intent is filed under Section 104.102, Utilities Code,
- 24 or for which a regulatory authority serves notice on a gas utility

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- 1 under Section 104.151, Utilities Code, before the effective date of
- 2 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the statement of
- 3 intent was filed or notice was served, and that law is continued in
- 4 effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
