A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the fee on delivery of certain petroleum products.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 26.3574(b), Water Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) A fee is imposed on the delivery of a petroleum product
- 7 on withdrawal from bulk of that product as provided by this
- 8 subsection. Each operator of a bulk facility on withdrawal from
- 9 bulk of a petroleum product shall collect from the person who orders
- 10 the withdrawal a fee in an amount determined as follows:
- 11 (1) \$3.75 for each delivery into a cargo tank having a
- 12 capacity of less than 2,500 gallons [for the state fiscal year
- 13 beginning September 1, 2007, through the state fiscal year ending
- 14 August 31, 2011];
- 15 (2) \$7.50 for each delivery into a cargo tank having a
- 16 capacity of 2,500 gallons or more but less than 5,000 gallons [for
- 17 the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2007, through the
- 18 state fiscal year ending August 31, 2011];
- 19 (3) \$11.75 for each delivery into a cargo tank having a
- 20 capacity of 5,000 gallons or more but less than 8,000 gallons [for
- 21 the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2007, through the
- 22 state fiscal year ending August 31, 2011];
- 23 (4) \$15.00 for each delivery into a cargo tank having a
- 24 capacity of 8,000 gallons or more but less than 10,000 gallons [for

- 1 the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2007, through the
- 2 state fiscal year ending August 31, 2011]; and
- 3 (5) \$7.50 for each increment of 5,000 gallons or any
- 4 part thereof delivered into a cargo tank having a capacity of 10,000
- 5 gallons or more [for the state fiscal year beginning September 1,
- 6 2007, through the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2011].
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
