- 5 SECTION 1. Section 442.021, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (c), (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The commission shall cooperate with the Texas
- 8 Department of Transportation to designate, interpret, and market
- 9 the El Camino Real de los Tejas National Historic Trail as a Texas
- 10 historic highway.
- 11 (d) To supplement revenue available for the purposes under
- 12 Subsection (c), the commission and the Texas Department of
- 13 Transportation may pursue federal funds dedicated to highway
- 14 <u>enhancement.</u>
- 15 (e) A designation of the El Camino Real de los Tejas
- 16 National Historic Trail as a Texas historic highway may not be
- 17 construed as a designation under the National Historic Preservation
- 18 <u>Act (16 U.S.C. Section 470 et seq.).</u>
- 19 <u>(f) The Texas Department of Transportation is not required</u>
- 20 to design, construct, or erect a marker under this section unless a
- 21 grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the
- 22 cost of the design, construction, and erection of the marker. Money
- 23 received to cover the cost of the marker shall be deposited to the
- 24 credit of the state highway fund.
