A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the use of auction proceeds from the sale of abandoned motor vehicles, watercraft, or outboard motors to compensate 3 certain property owners. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 683.015(f), Transportation Code, is 6 amended to read as follows: 7 (f) A [county] law enforcement agency may use funds 8 [received from the sale of a motor vehicle abandoned as a result of 9 a vehicular pursuit involving the law enforcement agency and] 10 11 transferred under Subsection (d) to compensate property owners 12 whose property was damaged as a result of <u>a</u> [the] pursuit <u>involving</u> the law enforcement agency, regardless of whether the agency would 13 14 be liable under Chapter 101, Civil Practice and Remedies Code. [A payment for compensation under this subsection may not exceed any 15 of the following amounts: 16 [(1) the net proceeds received from the sale of the 17 motor vehicle abandoned as a result of the pursuit; 18 [(2) \$1,000 per property owner, if more than one 19 property owner's property is damaged as a result of the pursuit; or 20 21 [(3) the amount of the property owner's insurance 22 deductible.] SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24
