7	amended to read as follows:
8	(f) A [county] law enforcement agency may use funds
9	[received from the sale of a motor vehicle abandoned as a result of
10	a vehicular pursuit involving the law enforcement agency and]
11	transferred under Subsection (d) to compensate property owners
12	whose property was damaged as a result of \underline{a} [the] pursuit involving
13	the law enforcement agency, regardless of whether the agency would
14	be liable under Chapter 101, Civil Practice and Remedies Code. [A
15	payment for compensation under this subsection may not exceed any
16	of the following amounts:
17	[(1) the net proceeds received from the sale of the
18	motor vehicle abandoned as a result of the pursuit;
19	[(2) \$1,000 per property owner, if more than one
20	property owner's property is damaged as a result of the pursuit; or
21	[(3) the amount of the property owner's insurance
22	deductible.
23	SECTION 2. Section 683.015(g), Transportation Code, is

24 repealed.
