1	AN ACT
2	relating to a continuous improvement process at state agencies.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 10, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 2116 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 2116. STATE AGENCY CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT PROCESS
7	Sec. 2116.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "continuous
8	improvement process" means a set of practices designed to improve
9	organizational operations and remove deficiencies.
10	Sec. 2116.002. EVALUATION OF A CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT
11	PROCESS. Each agency shall evaluate implementing a continuous
12	improvement process to increase efficiency and cost savings.
13	Sec. 2116.003. IMPLEMENTATION OF A CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT
14	PROCESS. After completing the requirements of section 2116.002,
15	the agency may implement the continuous improvement process.
16	Sec. 2116.004. REPORT. The evaluation and any
17	implementation activities shall be synopsized in the agency's
18	annual report.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
