- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 45, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 45.114 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 45.114. DEVELOPMENT OR SALE OF RIGHTS TO NATURAL
- 9 RESOURCES OR MINERALS IN LAND HELD FOR COUNTY PERMANENT SCHOOL FUND
- 10 BY WEBB COUNTY. Notwithstanding former Subchapter E, Chapter 17,
- 11 <u>as that subchapter existed on May 1, 199</u>5, the Commissioners Court
- 12 of Webb County may:

- (1) develop or sell the rights to natural resources or
- 14 minerals in lands held in trust by Webb County under Section 6,
- 15 Article VII, Texas Constitution; and
- (2) enter into an agreement described by Sections
- 17 6(b)(2) and (c), Article VII, Texas Constitution.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect December 1, 2011, but only
- 19 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature,
- 20 Regular Session, 2011, authorizing Webb County to obtain proceeds
- 21 of the county permanent school fund and recover from proceeds of the
- 22 county permanent school fund expenses incurred by the county in a
- 23 transaction to develop or sell rights to natural resources or
- 24 minerals in county permanent school fund property and distribute

- 1 the proceeds remaining after reimbursement to school districts for
- 2 which the property is held in trust is approved by the voters. If
- 3 that amendment is not approved, this Act has no effect.
