A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the board of hospital managers of the El Paso County
- 3 Hospital District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 281.021(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The El Paso County Commissioners Court shall appoint a
- 8 board composed of seven members, and shall by order provide for the
- 9 qualifications of appointees to the board and for approval to the
- 10 board following notice and public hearing.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 281, Health and Safety
- 12 Code, is amended by adding Section 281.0222 to read as follows:
- Sec. 281.0222. QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE. (a) This
- 14 section applies only to the El Paso County Hospital District.
- 15 (b) The El Paso County Commissioners Court may not appoint a
- 16 person to the board of hospital managers of the district if the
- 17 person is:
- 18 <u>(1) an employee of El Paso County;</u>
- 19 (2) a district employee;
- 20 (3) a party to a contract with the district to provide
- 21 goods or perform services for compensation; or
- 22 (4) related within the first degree of consanguinity
- 23 or affinity, as determined under Subchapter B, Chapter 573,
- 24 Government Code, to a member of the commissioners court or to a

- 1 person described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3).
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 281.031, Health and Safety Code, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 281.031. REMOVAL OF BOARD MEMBER. (a) A member of the
- 5 board of hospital managers of the El Paso County Hospital District
- 6 is considered to have resigned the member's position if the member:
- 7 (1) is absent from all the regularly scheduled board
- 8 and committee meetings that the member is eligible to attend during
- 9 a 90-day period; [or]
- 10 (2) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 11 scheduled board and committee meetings that the member is eligible
- 12 to attend during a 12-month period;
- 13 (3) fails to pay a local tax, including an ad valorem
- 14 tax, when due; or
- 15 <u>(4) would be ineligible to serve on the board as</u>
- 16 provided by Section 281.0222.
- 17 (b) A resignation under Subsection (a) is effective
- 18 immediately on the date the conduct or disqualification [absence or
- 19 refusal] prescribed by Subsection (a) occurs or is determined.
- 20 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 21 an appointment to the board of hospital managers of the El Paso
- 22 County Hospital District made on or after the effective date of this
- 23 Act. An appointment to the board of hospital managers of the El
- 24 Paso County Hospital District that occurs before the effective date
- 25 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 26 appointment was made, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 27 that purpose.

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- 1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
