- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is 5
- amended by adding Section 38.0111 to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 38.0111. RESTRICTIONS ON FOOD CONTAINING INDUSTRIALLY
- PRODUCED TRANS FAT. (a) In this section: 8
- 9 (1) "Industrially produced trans fat" includes
- vegetable shortening, margarine, and partially hydrogenated 10
- vegetable oil. 11

- 12 (2) "School food service establishment" means a place
- that regularly sells or serves food on a school campus. 13
- 14 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), a school
- district may not make available to students through a vending 15
- 16 machine or a school food service establishment a food that contains
- industrially produced trans fat or that was prepared using another 17
- food that contains industrially produced trans fat. 18
- (c) Subsection (b) does not apply on a day that school is not 19
- in session or: 20
- 21 (1) earlier than 30 minutes before the beginning of
- 22 the first scheduled class of the day; or
- 23 (2) later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the
- last scheduled class of the day. 24

- 1 (d) Subsection (b) does not apply to a food that:
- 2 (1) is provided to a school district as part of a
- 3 United States Department of Agriculture meal program; or
- 4 (2) contains zero grams of trans fat per serving,
- 5 according to the manufacturer's documentation or the label on the
- 6 food, as required by state or federal law or regulations.
- 7 (e) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary for the
- 8 administration of this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 38.0111, Education Code, as added by
- 10 this Act, applies beginning with the 2012-2013 school year.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
