A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to school district governance.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 11.051(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) An independent school district is governed by a board of
- 7 trustees who, as a body corporate, shall:
- 8 (1) provide policy leadership and oversee the
- 9 management of the district; and
- 10 (2) ensure that the superintendent implements and
- 11 monitors plans, procedures, programs, and systems to achieve
- 12 appropriate, clearly defined, and desired results in the major
- 13 areas of district operations.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.151(d), Education Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (d) The trustees shall [may] adopt rules and bylaws
- 17 necessary to carry out the powers and duties provided by Subsection
- 18 (b). Policies regarding district governance must be adopted by the
- 19 <u>trustees.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 11.1511, Education Code, is amended by
- 21 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 22 follows:
- 23 (c) The board may:
- 24 (1) issue bonds and levy, pledge, assess, and collect

- 1 an annual ad valorem tax to pay the principal and interest on the
- 2 bonds as authorized under Sections 45.001 and 45.003;
- 3 (2) levy, assess, and collect an annual ad valorem tax
- 4 for maintenance and operation of the district as authorized under
- 5 Sections 45.002 and 45.003;
- 6 (3) employ a person to assess or collect the district's
- 7 taxes as authorized under Section 45.231; and
- 8 (4) enter into contracts as authorized under this code
- 9 or other law and delegate contractual authority to the
- 10 superintendent as provided by Subsection (d) [appropriate].
- 11 (d) The board shall adopt a policy governing permissible
- 12 delegation of the board's contractual authority to the
- 13 <u>superintendent</u>. The policy must:
- 14 (1) prohibit delegation to the superintendent of
- 15 authority for a contract with a value that exceeds a specific amount
- 16 provided by the board; and
- 17 (2) provide for at least a quarterly review by the
- 18 board of contracts for which authority is delegated to the
- 19 superintendent.
- SECTION 4. Section 11.1512, Education Code, is amended by
- 21 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 22 follows:
- 23 (a) In relation to the superintendent of the school
- 24 district, the board of trustees of the district has the powers and
- 25 duties specified by Sections 11.1511(b) and (c). The
- 26 superintendent shall, on a day-to-day basis, ensure the
- 27 implementation of the policies created by the board. The

- 1 superintendent may not implement a policy change without approval
- 2 by the board.
- 3 (a-1) The superintendent has the exclusive responsibility
- 4 of resolving constituent disputes and problems with the district.
- 5 A trustee shall refer a constituent with a dispute or problem with
- 6 the district to the superintendent for resolution.
- 7 SECTION 5. Sections 11.1513(a), (b), and (f), Education
- 8 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) The board of trustees of each independent school
- 10 district shall adopt a policy providing for the employment and
- 11 duties of district personnel. The employment policy must provide
- 12 that:
- 13 (1) the board employs and evaluates the
- 14 superintendent;
- 15 (2) the superintendent has final authority regarding
- 16 the selection of all personnel other than the superintendent,
- 17 unless the board reserves final authority regarding that selection,
- 18 in which case the superintendent has sole authority to make
- 19 recommendations to the board regarding the selection of all
- 20 personnel other than the superintendent[, except that the board may
- 21 delegate final authority for those decisions to the
- 22 superintendent]; and
- 23 (3) each principal must approve each teacher or staff
- 24 appointment to the principal's campus as provided by Section
- 25 11.202.
- 26 (b) In a school district in which the board reserves final
- 27 authority regarding the selection of all personnel other than the

- 1 <u>superintendent</u>, the [The] board of trustees may accept or reject
- 2 the superintendent's recommendation regarding the selection of
- 3 district personnel and shall include the board's acceptance or
- 4 rejection in the minutes of the board's meeting, as required under
- 5 Section 551.021, Government Code, in the certified agenda or tape
- 6 recording required under Section 551.103, Government Code, or in
- 7 the recording required under Section 551.125 or 551.127, Government
- 8 Code, as applicable. If the board rejects the superintendent's
- 9 recommendation, the superintendent shall make alternative
- 10 recommendations until the board accepts a recommendation.
- 11 (f) If, under the employment policy, [the board of trustees
- 12 delegates to] the superintendent has [the] final authority to
- 13 select district personnel:
- 14 (1) the superintendent is a public official for
- 15 purposes of Chapter 573, Government Code, only with respect to a
- 16 decision made under that [delegation of] authority; and
- 17 (2) each member of the board of trustees remains
- 18 subject to Chapter 573, Government Code, with respect to all
- 19 district employees.
- SECTION 6. Section 11.159, Education Code, is amended by
- 21 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 22 follows:
- 23 (b) A trustee must complete the [any] training required by
- 24 the State Board of Education. The minutes of the last regular
- 25 meeting of the board of trustees held during a calendar year must
- 26 reflect whether each trustee has met or is delinquent in meeting the
- 27 training required to be completed as of the date of the meeting.

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- 1 (c) The State Board of Education shall ensure that the
- 2 training required to be completed by a trustee under Subsection (b)
- 3 <u>includes at least six hours in team-building training each year and</u>
- 4 includes discussion of the distinction between governance and
- 5 management and the evaluation of board and superintendent
- 6 <u>leadership</u>, governance, and teamwork.
- 7 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
