- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sec. 56.465, Subchapter Q, Chapter 56, Education
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing board of each institution of higher
- 8 education shall cause to be set aside five percent of the amount of
- 9 the tuition charged to a resident undergraduate student at the
- 10 institution under Section 54.0513 in excess of \$46 per semester
- 11 credit hour. The amount of a student's tuition set aside under this
- 12 subsection is considered a part of the amount required to be set
- 13 aside from that tuition under Section 56.011.
- 14 (b) The amount of tuition set aside under Subsection (a)
- 15 shall be deposited to the credit of the Texas B-On-time student loan
- 16 account established under Section 56.463 or to the interest and
- 17 sinking fund established by the coordinating board under Section
- 18 52.91(b) in accordance with the resolution of the board
- 19 establishing such fund. held in reserve at the institution the
- 20 student attends and distributed to students at that institution in
- 21 <u>accordance with this subchapter.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
