5	SECTION 1. Section 39.022, Education Code, is amended to

7	Sec. 39.022. ASSESSMENT PROGRAM. The State Board of
8	Education by rule shall create and implement a statewide assessment
9	program that is knowledge- and skills-based to ensure school
10	accountability for student achievement that achieves the goals
11	provided under Section 4.002. The board may adopt rules to the
12	extent necessary for the administration of the assessment program
13	in accordance with this subchapter. [After adopting rules under
14	this section, the State Board of Education shall consider the
15	importance of maintaining stability in the statewide assessment
16	program when adopting any subsequent modification of the rules.

- 15 Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 15. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 17 school year.
- 18 SECTION 16. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 19 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 20 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 21 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 22 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
