- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 542.402, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) In each fiscal year, except as provided by Subsection
- 9 (b-1), a municipality having a population of less than 5,000 may
- 10 retain, from fines collected for violations of this title and from
- 11 special expenses collected under Article 45.051, Code of Criminal
- 12 Procedure, in cases in which a violation of this title is alleged,
- 13 an amount equal to 30 percent of the municipality's revenue for the
- 14 preceding fiscal year from all sources, other than federal funds
- 15 and bond proceeds, as shown by the audit performed under Section
- 16 103.001, Local Government Code. After a municipality has retained
- 17 that amount, the municipality shall send to the comptroller any
- 18 portion of a fine or a special expense collected that exceeds \$1.
- 19 (b-1) A municipality may retain an amount in excess of the
- 20 limitation imposed by Subsection (b) if the excess amount retained
- 21 is used exclusively to fund fire, rescue, and emergency medical
- 22 services, including any necessary support services for those
- 23 functions.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section

- 1 542.402, Transportation Code, applies only to a fiscal year of a
- 2 municipality that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
