AN ACT

- 2 relating to the provision of certain prescription medications to a
 3 foster child.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 226, Family Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 266.0042 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 266.0042. PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION REQUIREMENTS. (a)
- 8 Except in the case of an emergency, a foster child may not be
- 9 prescribed more than <u>four prescription</u> <u>medications to be taken</u>
- 10 concurrently unless the decision to prescribe the medications is
- 11 reviewed and approved by an independent physician provided by the
- 12 managed care organization providing health care services to the
- 13 <u>child under the STAR Health program.</u>

- 14 (b) The department shall maintain a record of all
- 15 medications prescribed for a child in the conservatorship of the
- 16 department. The record must include, for each medication, the name
- 17 of the medication, the dosage amount, and the frequency with which
- 18 the child is to receive the medication.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
