- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 5.753(b), Water Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (b) The components of compliance history must include:
- 9 (1) enforcement orders, court judgments, consent
- 10 decrees, and criminal convictions of  $\underline{a}$  local government to which
- 11 the commission refers complaints for investigation, this state, and
- 12 the federal government relating to compliance with applicable legal
- 13 requirements under the jurisdiction of the commission or the United
- 14 States Environmental Protection Agency;
- 15 (2) notwithstanding any other provision of this code,
- 16 orders issued under Section 7.070;
- 17 (3) to the extent readily available to the commission,
- 18 enforcement orders, court judgments, and criminal convictions
- 19 relating to violations of environmental laws of other states; and
- 20 (4) changes in ownership.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to an enforcement order, court judgment, consent decree, or
- 23 criminal conviction of a local government that becomes final on or
- 24 after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
