## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the repeal of the motor fuels tax exemption for
- 3 biodiesel and renewable diesel.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 162, Section 162.204, Subsection (a)(9),
- 6 Tax Code, is amended as follows:
- 7 (9) the volume of water, fuel ethanol, renewable diesel,
- 8 biodiesel, or mixtures thereof that are blended together with
- 9 taxable diesel fuel when the finished product sold or used is
- 10 clearly identified on the retail pump, storage tank, and sales
- 11 invoice as a combination of diesel fuel and water, fuel ethanol,
- 12 renewable diesel, biodiesel, or mixtures thereof;
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
