5	SECTION 1. Section 102.017, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by amending Subsection (d-1) as follows:
7	(d-1) For purposes of this article, the term "security
8	personnel, services, and items" includes:
9	(1) the purchase or repair of X-ray machines and conveying
10	systems;
11	(2) handheld metal detectors;
12	(3) walkthrough metal detectors;
13	(4) identification cards and systems;
14	(5) electronic locking and surveillance equipment;
15	(6) bailiffs, deputy sheriffs, deputy constables or
16	contract security personnel during times when they are providing
17	appropriate security services;
18	(7) signage;
19	(8) confiscated weapon inventory and tracking systems;
20	(9) locks, chains, alarms, or similar security devices;
21	(10) the purchase or repair of bullet-proof glass; and
22	(11) continuing education on security issues for court
23	personnel and security personnel+; and

(12) warrant officers and related equipment.
