## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to certain unprofessional conduct by a health care
  3 provider.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 105.002(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A health care provider commits unprofessional conduct
- 8 if the health care provider, in connection with the provider's
- 9 professional activities:
- 10 (1) knowingly presents or causes to be presented a
- 11 false or fraudulent claim for the payment of a loss under an
- 12 insurance policy;
- 13 (2) knowingly prepares, makes, or subscribes to any
- 14 writing, with intent to present or use the writing, or to allow it
- 15 to be presented or used, in support of a false or fraudulent claim
- 16 under an insurance policy; [or]
- 17 (3) knowingly directs or requires a patient to obtain
- 18 health care goods or services from a niche hospital in which the
- 19 health care provider or an immediate family member of the provider
- 20 has a financial interest, unless the provider:
- 21 (A) discloses to the patient, in writing, that
- 22 the provider or the provider's family member has a financial
- 23 interest in the niche hospital; and
- 24 (B) informs the patient that the patient has the

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- 1 option of using an alternative health care facility; or
- 2 (4) knowingly fails to allow a patient, when requested
- 3 by the patient or a guardian authorized to consent to treatment for
- 4 the patient, to have another person present with the patient during
- 5 an examination, service, or procedure to observe the patient or
- 6 health care provider.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
