2	relating to the effect on local regulation of the use and sale of
3	fireworks.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2154.004, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
7	follows:
8	(b) This chapter [does not limit or restrict the authority
9	of a county, where specifically authorized by law, or municipality
10	to enact an ordinance or order prohibiting or further regulating
11	fireworks governs the regulation of fireworks in this state,
12	<pre>except that:</pre>
13	(1) a municipality may regulate the sale and use of
14	<u>fireworks:</u>
15	(A) within its corporate boundaries; and
16	(B) in the existing area outside those boundaries
17	specified by Section 217.042(a), Local Government Code, if the
18	municipality prohibited or regulated fireworks in those areas
19	existing prior to September 1, 2011.
20	(2) after September 1, 2011, a municipality may not,
21	after annexing an area, adopt a regulation to prohibit a person
22	<pre>from:</pre>
23	(A) continuing to use the land for the lawful
2/1	sale and nossession of 1 AC fireworks in the area in the manner in

- 1 which the land was being used on the date the annexation proceedings
- 2 were instituted if the land use was legal at that time; or
- 3 (B) beginning to use land in the area in the
- 4 manner that was planned for the land before the 90th day before the
- 5 effective date of the annexation if one or more licenses,
- 6 certificates, permits, approvals, or other forms of authorization
- 7 by a governmental entity were required by law for the planned land
- 8 use and a completed application for the initial authorization was
- 9 filed with the governmental entity before the date the annexation
- 10 proceedings were instituted.
- 11 (2) the commissioner's court of a county may regulate
- 12 restricted fireworks under the provisions of Section 352.051(c),
- 13 Local Government Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
