## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to cash payments provided to an inmate released on parole, mandatory supervision, or conditional pardon from the Texas 3 Department of Criminal Justice. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 501.015(b), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows: 7 (b) When an inmate is released on parole, mandatory 8 9 supervision, or conditional pardon, [the inmate is entitled to receive \$100 from] the department shall provide the inmate with \$50 10 on the inmate's release from the facility and transportation at the 11 12 expense of the department to: (1) the location at which the inmate is required to 13 14 report to a parole officer, if the inmate is required to report to a parole officer; 15 16

(2) [by the pardons and paroles division. The inmate shall receive \$50 on his release from the institution and \$50 on 17 initially reporting to a parole officer at the location at which the 18 inmate is required to report to a parole officer. If an inmate is 19 released and is not required by the pardons and paroles division to 20 report to a parole officer or is authorized by the pardons and 21 paroles division to report to a location outside this state, the 22 23 department shall provide the inmate with \$100 and, at the expense of 2.4 the department, transportation to:

- 1  $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$  the location of the inmate's residence, if the
- 2 residence is in this state <u>and the inmate is not required to report</u>
- 3 to a parole officer; or
- 4 (3)  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  a transit point determined appropriate by
- 5 the department, if the inmate's residence is outside this state or
- 6 the inmate is required [by the pardons and paroles division] to
- 7 report to a location outside this state.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 499.155(c), Government Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (c) If an inmate is discharged or released on parole or
- 11 mandatory supervision from a transfer facility, the inmate is
- 12 entitled to receive release or discharge money from the department
- 13 [institutional division] in the same amount as an inmate is
- 14 entitled to receive on release or discharge from any other facility
- 15 of the <u>department</u> [<u>institutional division</u>] under Section 501.015.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
