- 2 relating to contributions by public retirement systems to the State
- 3 Pension Review Board fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 801.113(c) and (e), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The governing board of \underline{a} [any] public retirement system
- 8 <u>shall</u> [may vote to] make an annual contribution to the State Pension
- 9 Review Board in an amount equal [not] to [exceed] 50 cents for each
- 10 active member and annuitant of the retirement system as of
- 11 September 1 of the year for which the contribution is made. The
- 12 contribution is payable in a lump sum.
- 13 (e) The board is authorized to conduct training sessions,
- 14 schools, or other educational activities for trustees and
- 15 administrators of public retirement systems. The board may also
- 16 furnish other appropriate services such as actuarial studies or
- 17 other requirements of systems and may establish appropriate fees
- 18 for these activities and services. [The fees may be based on
- 19 whether or not the trustees, administrators, or systems contribute
- 20 to the State Pension Review Board fund under Subsection (c) of this
- 21 section.] The net proceeds of these fees shall be deposited in the
- 22 fund.
- 23 SECTION 2. The governing board of a public retirement
- 24 system shall make the initial contribution required under Section

- 1 801.113(c), Government Code, as amended by this Act, to the State
- 2 Pension Review Board fund as required by that section on or before
- 3 September 1, 2011.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 9 legislative session.
