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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 151.024, Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- Sec. 151.024. PERSONS WHO MAY BE REGARDED AS RETAILERS. (a) 8
- 9 If the comptroller determines that it is necessary for
- 10 efficient administration of this chapter to regard a salesman,
- representative, peddler, or canvasser as the agent of a dealer, 11
- 12 distributor, supervisor, or employer under whom he operates or from
- whom he obtains the tangible personal property that he sells, 13
- 14 whether or not the sale is made in his own behalf or for the dealer,
- distributor, supervisor, or employer, the comptroller may so regard 15
- 16 the salesman, representative, peddler, or canvasser, and may regard
- 17 the dealer, distributor, supervisor, or employer as a retailer or
- seller for the purpose of this chapter. 18
- 19 (b) The comptroller may regard a salesman,
- representative, peddler, or canvasser as the agent of a dealer, 20
- distributor, supervisor, or employer under Subsection (a) of this 21
- section only after providing written notice to the dealer, 22
- 23 distributor, supervisor, or employer at least 90 days before the
- first day of the first calendar month or calendar quarter for which 24

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- 1 the comptroller will so regard a salesman, representative, peddler,
- 2 or canvasser. Notice under this section shall be mailed to the
- 3 dealer, distributor, supervisor, or employer at the address shown
- 4 in the comptroller's records.
- 5 <u>(c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a salesman,</u>
- 6 representative, peddler, or canvasser who is the agent in fact of a
- 7 dealer, distributor, supervisor, or employer. A person is the
- 8 agent in fact of a dealer, distributor, supervisor, or employer if
- 9 the dealer, distributor, supervisor, or employer has authorized the
- 10 person to act on behalf of and to bind the dealer, distributor,
- 11 supervisor, or employer.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
