16	(c) An unsworn declaration made under this section must be:

An unsworn 6 declaration executed before the effective date of this Act is 7 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date 8 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
