| 10 | minimal nutritional value on the school campus. |
| 11 | (b) The department shall adopt rules as necessary for the |
| 12 | administration of this section. The rules must identify or |
| 13 | establish criteria for identifying foods of minimal nutritional |
| 14 | value. |
| 15 | SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date |
| 16 | of this Act, the Department of Agriculture shall adopt rules for the |
| 17 | administration of Section 12.0022, Agriculture Code, as added by |
| 18 | this Act. |
| 19 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 20 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
| 21 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this |
| 22 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |
| 23 | Act takes effect September 1, 2011. |
