1	AN ACT
2	relating to the conversion of a nontolled state highway or segment
3	of the state highway system to a toll project.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 228.201(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The [Except as provided by Section 228.2015, the]
8	department may not operate a nontolled state highway or a segment of
9	a nontolled state highway as a toll project, and may not transfer a
10	nontolled highway or segment to another entity for operation as a
11	toll project, unless:

- 12 (1) the commission by order designated the highway or
- 13 segment as a toll project before the contract to construct the
- 14 highway or segment was awarded;
- 15 (2) [the highway or segment was open to traffic as a
- 16 turnpike project on or before September 1, 2005;
- 17 [(3) the project was designated as a toll project in a
- 18 plan or program of a metropolitan planning organization on or
- 19 before September 1, 2005;
- 20 $[\frac{(4)}{}]$ the highway or segment is reconstructed so that
- 21 the number of nontolled lanes on the highway or segment is greater
- 22 than or equal to the number in existence before the reconstruction;
- 23 $\underline{(3)}$ [$\overline{(5)}$] a facility that has access, function, and
- 24 control devices similar to the converted highway or segment before

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- 1 conversion is constructed adjacent to the highway or segment so
- 2 that the number of nontolled lanes on the converted highway or
- 3 segment and the adjacent facility together is greater than or equal
- 4 to the number in existence on the converted highway or segment
- 5 before the conversion; or
- 6 (4) (4) subject to Subsection (b), the highway or
- 7 segment was open to traffic as a high-occupancy vehicle lane on May
- 8 1, 2005[; or
- 9 [(7) the commission converts the highway or segment to
- 10 a toll facility by:
- 11 [(A) making the determination required by
- 12 Section 228.202;
- 13 [(B) conducting the hearing required by Section
- 14 228.203; and
- 15 [(C) obtaining county and voter approval as
- 16 required by Sections 228.207 and 228.208].
- 17 SECTION 2. Sections 228.202, 228.203, 228.207, and 228.208,
- 18 Transportation Code, are repealed.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
