BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. STUDY ON EMERGENCY SERVICES IN RURAL AREAS. (a)
In this section, "first responder" has the meaning assigned by
Section 421.095, Government Code.

7 (b) The Commission on State Emergency Communications shall8 conduct a study to:

9 (1) evaluate access to 9-1-1 communications in rural 10 areas and the ability of first responders to respond to emergencies 11 in rural areas; and

(2) provide recommendations for the creation of a program that will maximize the use of federal and state funding for 9-1-1 services to ensure rural areas have greater access to 9-1-1 communications and first responders are able to respond more efficiently to emergencies in rural areas.

(c) Not later than December 1, 2012, the Commission on State Emergency Communications shall submit a report containing the findings of the study conducted under Subsection (b) of this section and the commission's recommendations to the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives.
