BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-12 SECTION 1. Section 31.108(f), Parks and Wildlife Code, is 1-13 amended to read as follows:

(f) An agent acting under authority of Subsection (d):

1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 (1) shall collect a \$10 examination or course fee and forward the fee and any examination documentation to the department 1-17 not later than the 30th day after the date the examination or course 1-18 is administered; and

1-19 (2) may collect and keep a \$3 service fee, or an amount 1-20 1-21 set by the commission, whichever is greater. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-24 1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
