A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of and powers and duties of the
- 3 Commission on Jail Standards.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 511.004(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The commission consists of $\underline{15}$ [nine] members appointed
- 8 by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. Two
- 9 <u>members</u> [One member] must be <u>sheriffs</u> [a sheriff] of <u>counties</u> [a
- 10 county] with populations [a population] of more than 35,000, two
- 11 members [one] must be sheriffs [a sheriff] of counties [a county]
- 12 with populations [a population] of 35,000 or less, three members
- 13 [one] must be [a] county judges [judge], three members [one] must be
- 14 [a] county commissioners [commissioner], one member must be a
- 15 practitioner of medicine licensed by the Texas State Board of
- 16 Medical Examiners, and the other four members must be
- 17 representatives of the general public. At least one of the four
- 18 citizen members must be from a county with a population of 35,000 or
- 19 less.
- 20 (b) The sheriffs, county <u>judges</u> [judge], and county
- 21 <u>commissioners</u> [commissioner] appointed to the commission shall
- 22 perform the duties of a member in addition to their other duties.
- SECTION 2. Section 511.0091, Government Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (c-2) to read as follows:

- 1 (c-2) In addition to the other fees authorized by this
- 2 section, the commission by a two-thirds vote may set and collect a
- 3 reasonable annual fee from each jail under the commission's
- 4 jurisdiction.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 511.011, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 511.011. REPORT ON NONCOMPLIANCE. If the commission
- 8 finds that a county jail does not comply with state law, including
- 9 Chapter 89, Health and Safety Code, or the rules, standards, or
- 10 procedures of the commission adopted under Section 511.009(a)(2),
- 11 it shall report the noncompliance to the county commissioners and
- 12 sheriff of the county responsible for the county jail and shall send
- 13 a copy of the report to the governor.
- 14 SECTION 4. (a) Promptly after this Act takes effect, the
- 15 governor shall appoint six additional members to the Commission on
- 16 Jail Standards. In appointing those members, the governor shall
- 17 appoint two people to terms expiring January 31, 2013, two people to
- 18 terms expiring January 31, 2015, and two people to terms expiring
- 19 January 31, 2017. The governor shall ensure that the appointments
- 20 to the commission comply with the requirements of Section
- 21 511.004(a), Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 22 (b) Until all appointees to the Commission on Jail Standards
- 23 have taken office, a quorum of the commission is a majority of the
- 24 number of members who are qualified.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
