## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the accommodation of bicycles, pedestrians, and mass

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 201.622 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 201.622. ACCOMMODATION OF BICYCLISTS, PEDESTRIANS,
- 8 AND MASS TRANSIT RIDERS. (a) In this section, "local authority"
- 9 means a county, municipality, or other local entity authorized to
- 10 plan, construct, and maintain streets and highways.
- 11 (b) The commission shall adopt provisions relating to the
- 12 accommodation of bicycles, pedestrians, and mass transit riders in
- 13 <u>transportation planning</u>.
- 14 (c) To implement this section, the department shall
- 15 establish minimum guidelines to accommodate bicycles, pedestrians,
- 16 and mass transit riders in all transportation planning,
- 17 construction, reconstruction, street or highway improvements, and
- 18 transportation facilities, including mass transit facilities. The
- 19 guidelines must conform to the provisions for bicycle, pedestrian,
- 20 and mass transit rider accommodation adopted under Subsection (b).
- 21 <u>(d) To implement this section or a local ordinance, a local</u>
- 22 <u>authority shall establish minimum guidelines to accommodate</u>
- 23 bicycles, pedestrians, and mass transit riders in all
- 24 transportation planning, construction, reconstruction, street or

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- 1 highway improvements, and transportation facilities, including
- 2 mass transit facilities. The guidelines must conform to the
- 3 provisions for bicycle, pedestrian, and mass transit rider
- 4 <u>accommodation adopted under Subsection (b).</u>
- 5 (e) A metropolitan planning organization shall establish
- 6 minimum guidelines to accommodate bicycles, pedestrians, and mass
- 7 transit riders in any transportation improvement plan. The
- 8 guidelines must conform to the provisions for bicycle, pedestrian,
- 9 and mass transit rider accommodation adopted under Subsection (b).
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
