Section 6, Chapter 1214, Acts of the 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended by adding Subsection 6 (c) to read as follows: 7 (c) In addition to the rights, powers, privileges, 8 authority, functions, and duties under Subsection (a) of this 9 section, the district has all of the rights, powers, privileges, 10 authority, functions, and duties relating to: 11

14 (2) supply and distribution facilities or systems to 15 provide potable and nonpotable water to the residents and 16 businesses of Travis and Hays Counties.

(a) The legal notice of the intention to 18 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 19 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 20 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 21 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 22 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 23 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has

submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
Environmental Quality.

3 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 4 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 5 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 6 representatives within the required time.

7 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 8 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 9 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 10 and accomplished.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
