5	SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 1214, Acts of the 71st
6	Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [DEFINITION]. In this Act:
8	(1) "Board" means the board of directors of the
9	district.
10	(2) "District" [, "district"] means West Travis County
11	Municipal Utility District No. 5.
12	SECTION 2. Section 6, Chapter 1214, Acts of the 71st
13	Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended by adding Subsection
14	(c) to read as follows:
15	(c) In addition to the rights, powers, privileges,
16	authority, functions, and duties under Subsection (a), the district
17	has all of the rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions,
18	and duties relating to:
19	(1) road districts and road utility districts created
20	under Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
21	(2) supply and distribution facilities or systems to
22	provide potable and nonpotable water to the residents and
23	businesses of Travis and Hays Counties.
24	SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to

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1 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
2 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
3 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
4 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
5 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
6 Government Code.

7 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 8 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 9 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 10 (C)its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 11 12 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives within the required time. 13

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled and accomplished.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
