A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the selection of and requirements for serving as a

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 821.001(5), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (5) "Board of trustees" means the board appointed or
- 9 elected under this subtitle to administer the retirement system.
- 10 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 825.002, Government Code,
- 11 is amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 825.002. <u>APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF</u> TRUSTEES
- 13 [APPOINTED BY COVERNOR].
- 14 SECTION 3. Sections 825.002(a), (c), (d), and (e),
- 15 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The governor shall appoint, with the advice and consent
- 17 of the senate and as provided by this section, $\underline{\text{three}}$ [seven] members
- 18 of the board of trustees.
- 19 (c) Members of the retirement system whose most recent
- 20 credited service was performed for a public school district [The
- 21 governor] shall elect under rules adopted by the board [appoint]
- 22 two members of the board, who must be [from a slate of three]
- 23 members of the retirement system and be [who are] currently
- 24 employed by a public school district [and who have been nominated in

- 1 accordance with Subsection (f) by the members of the retirement
- 2 system whose most recent credited service was performed for a
- 3 public school district]. The two members hold office for staggered
- 4 terms.
- 5 (d) Persons who have retired and are receiving benefits from
- 6 the retirement system [The governor] shall elect under rules
- 7 <u>adopted by the board</u> [appoint] one member of the board, who must be
- 8 a [from a slate of three] former member [members] of the retirement
- 9 system who is [have] retired and [are] receiving benefits from the
- 10 retirement system [and who have been nominated in accordance with
- 11 Subsections (f) and (g) by the persons who have retired and are
- 12 receiving benefits from the retirement system].
- 13 (e) Members of the retirement system whose most recent
- 14 credited service was performed for an institution of higher
- 15 <u>education</u> [The governor] shall <u>elect under rules adopted by the</u>
- 16 <u>board</u> [appoint] one member, who must be a member [from a slate of
- 17 three members] of the retirement system and be [who are] currently
- 18 employed by an institution of higher education [and who have been
- 19 nominated in accordance with Subsection (f) by the members of the
- 20 retirement system whose most recent credited service was performed
- 21 for an institution of higher education].
- SECTION 4. Sections 825.0032(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 23 are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person is not
- 25 eligible for appointment or election to the board if the person or
- 26 the person's spouse:
- 27 (1) is employed by or participates in the management

- 1 of a business entity or other organization receiving funds from the
- 2 retirement system;
- 3 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 4 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 5 organization receiving funds from the retirement system; or
- 6 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 7 goods, services, or funds from the retirement system, other than
- 8 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for board
- 9 membership, attendance, or expenses.
- 10 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 11 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 12 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 13 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who
- 14 is elected [nominated for appointment] under Section 825.002(c),
- 15 (d), or (e).
- SECTION 5. Section 825.0041, Government Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 825.0041. BOARD MEMBER TRAINING. (a) A person who is
- 19 appointed or elected to and qualifies for office as a member of the
- 20 board of trustees may not vote, deliberate, or be counted as a
- 21 member in attendance at a meeting of the board until the person
- 22 completes a training program that complies with this section.
- 23 (b) A training program must provide the person with
- 24 information regarding:
- 25 (1) the legislation that created the retirement system
- 26 and the board of trustees;
- 27 (2) the policy-making functions of the board;

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                (3) the [system's] programs operated by the retirement
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    system;
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                (4) the role and [\tau] functions of the retirement
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    system;
                (5) the [\tau] rules of the retirement system, with an

    emphasis on the rules that relate to disciplinary and investigatory
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    authority;

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                (7) [(2)] the results of the most recent formal audit
    of the retirement system;

- 7 SECTION 7. Sections 825.010(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 8 are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board that a trustee:
- 10 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the
- 11 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 12 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the
- 13 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 14 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section
- 15 825.002(b) or 825.0032;
- 16 (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge
- 17 the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which
- 18 the trustee is appointed or elected; or
- 19 (5) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 20 scheduled board meetings that the person is eligible to attend
- 21 during a calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority vote
- 22 of the board.
- 23 (c) If the executive director has knowledge that a potential
- 24 ground for removal exists, the executive director shall notify the
- 25 presiding officer of the board of the ground. The presiding officer
- 26 shall then notify the appropriate appointing officer, if any, and
- 27 the attorney general that a potential ground for removal exists. If

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- 1 the potential ground for removal involves the presiding officer,
- 2 the executive director shall notify the next highest officer of the
- 3 board, who shall notify the appropriate appointing officer, if any,
- 4 and the attorney general that a potential ground for removal
- 5 exists.
- 6 SECTION 8. Sections 825.002(f) and (g), Government Code,
- 7 are repealed.
- 8 SECTION 9. (a) Section 825.002, Government Code, as
- 9 amended by this Act, applies only to the appointment or election of
- 10 a member of the board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement System
- 11 of Texas that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 (b) The change in the manner of appointing or electing
- 13 members of the board does not affect the appointment of members
- 14 serving on the board before the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 16 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 17 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 18 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 19 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
