## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the selection of certain members of the board of
- 3 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 821.001(5), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (5) "Board of trustees" means the board appointed or
- 8 <u>elected</u> under this subtitle to administer the retirement system.
- 9 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 825.002, Government Code,
- 10 is amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 825.002. APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF TRUSTEES
- 12 [APPOINTED BY COVERNOR].
- 13 SECTION 3. Sections 825.002(a), (c), (d), and (e),
- 14 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The governor shall appoint, with the advice and consent
- 16 of the senate and as provided by this section, three [seven] members
- 17 of the board of trustees, in addition to the two appointees
- 18 nominated and confirmed in the manner described in Sec. 825.003.
- 19 (b) The governor shall appoint three members of the board to
- 20 hold office for staggered terms, with the term of one trustee
- 21 expiring on August 31 of each odd-numbered year. These members must
- 22 be persons who have demonstrated financial expertise, who have
- 23 worked in private business or industry, and who have broad
- 24 investment experience, preferably in investment of pension funds.

- 1 None of the members appointed under this subsection may be a member
- or annuitant of the retirement system. 2

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- 3 Members of the retirement system whose most recent
- credited service was performed for a public school district [The
- governor] shall elect under rules adopted by the board [appoint] 5
- two members of the board  $\underline{\text{who must be}}$  [from a slate of three] members 6
- 7 of the retirement system and [who are] currently employed by a
- public school district [and who have been nominated in accordance 8
- with Subsection (f) by the members of the retirement system whose 9
- 10 most recent credited service was performed for a public school
- district]. The two members hold office for staggered terms. 11
- 12 Persons who have retired and are receiving benefits from
- the retirement system [The governor] shall elect under rules 13
- 14 adopted by the board [appoint] one member of the board who must be a
- 15 [from a slate of three] former  $frame{member}$   $[frame{member}]$  of the retirement
- system who  $\underline{is}$  [have] retired and [are] receiving benefits from the 16
- 17 retirement system [and who have been nominated in accordance with
- Subsections (f) and (q) by the persons who have retired and are 18
- 19 receiving benefits from the retirement system].
- Members of the retirement system whose most recent 20 (e)
- credited service was performed for an institution of higher 21
- education [The governor] shall elect under rules adopted by the 22
- board [appoint] one member who must be a member [from a slate of 23
- 24 three members] of the retirement system and [who are] currently
- employed by an institution of higher education [and who have been 25
- 26 nominated in accordance with Subsection (f) by the members of the
- retirement system whose most recent credited service was performed 27

- 1 for an institution of higher education].
- 2 SECTION 4. Sections 825.0032(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 3 are amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person is not
- 5 eligible for appointment or election to the board if the person or
- 6 the person's spouse:
- 7 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- 8 of a business entity or other organization receiving funds from the
- 9 retirement system;
- 10 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 11 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 12 organization receiving funds from the retirement system; or
- 13 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 14 goods, services, or funds from the retirement system, other than
- 15 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for board
- 16 membership, attendance, or expenses.
- 17 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 18 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 19 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 20 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who
- 21 is <u>elected</u> [nominated for appointment] under Section 825.002(c),
- 22 (d), or (e).
- SECTION 5. Section 825.0041(b), Government Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- 25 (b) A training program established under this section shall
- 26 provide information to the member regarding:
- 27 (1) the enabling legislation that created the

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- 1 retirement system and its policy-making body to which the member is
- 2 appointed or elected to serve;
- 3 (2) the programs operated by the system;
- 4 (3) the role and functions of the system;
- 5 (4) the rules of the system with an emphasis on the
- 6 rules that relate to disciplinary and investigatory authority;
- 7 (5) the current budget for the system;
- 8 (6) the results of the most recent formal audit of the
- 9 system;
- 10 (7) the requirements of the:
- 11 (A) open meetings law, Chapter 551;
- 12 (B) open records law, Chapter 552; and
- 13 (C) administrative procedure law, Chapter 2001;
- 14 (8) the requirements of the conflict of interest laws
- 15 and other laws relating to public officials; and
- 16 (9) any applicable ethics policies adopted by the
- 17 system or the Texas Ethics Commission.
- 18 SECTION 6. Section 825.009(a), Government Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (a) A trustee <u>elected</u> [appointed from a slate of members
- 21 nominated by members of the retirement system] under Section
- 22 825.002 is entitled to leave with pay from the trustee's public
- 23 school employer to attend to the official business of the
- 24 retirement system.
- 25 SECTION 7. Section 825.010(a), Government Code, is amended
- 26 to read as follows:
- 27 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board if a trustee:

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- 1 (1) does not have at the time of appointment  $\underline{or}$
- 2 election the qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 3 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the
- 4 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 5 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section
- 6 825.002(b) or 825.0032;
- 7 (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge
- 8 the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which
- 9 the trustee is appointed or elected; or
- 10 (5) is absent from more than one-third of the
- 11 regularly scheduled board meetings that the person is eligible to
- 12 attend during a calendar year unless the absence is excused by
- 13 majority vote of the board.
- SECTION 8. Sections 825.002(f) and (g), Government Code,
- 15 are repealed.
- 16 SECTION 9. (a) Section 825.002, Government Code, as amended
- 17 by this Act, applies only to the appointment or election of a member
- 18 of the board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas
- 19 that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 (b) The change in the manner of appointing or electing
- 21 members of the board does not affect the appointment of members
- 22 serving on the board before the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 24 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 25 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 26 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 27 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
