Section 121.202, Utilities Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 follows: 7 Except as provided by Subsection (a) and by Section 8 (b) 9 121.2025, this subchapter does not reduce, limit, or impair: a power vested by law in: 10 (1)11 (A) a county in relation to a county road; or 12 (B) a municipality; or the ability of a municipality to establish 13 (2) 14 conditions for mapping or taking an inventory of pipelines and related appurtenances, including pumps, compressors, separators, 15 dehydration units, and tank batteries, located in an area in the 16 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction. 17 18 (c) A municipality may [+ [(A)] adopt an ordinance 19 that establishes conditions for mapping, inventorying, locating, or relocating 20 pipelines and related appurtenances, including pumps, compressors, 21 separators, dehydration units, and tank batteries, located within 22 23 [over, under, along, or across a public street or alley or private residential area in] the boundaries of the municipality [; or 24

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1 [(B) establish conditions for mapping or taking 2 an inventory in an area in a municipality's extraterritorial 3 jurisdiction].

4 SECTION 2. Section 181.006, Utilities Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 Sec. 181.006. CONSENT REQUIRED IN MUNICIPALITY. A gas 7 corporation may exercise authority under <u>Sections 181.004 and</u> 8 [Section] 181.005 in relation to a municipal street or alley with 9 the consent of and subject to the direction of the governing body of 10 the municipality.

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
