A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the validation of the creation, operation, and
- 3 dissolution of, and certain acts related to, a venue project.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The legislature validates and confirms:
- 6 (1) the creation of, and election on, a venue project
- 7 to finance the restoration and renovation of a venue as of the date
- 8 of an election held before the effective date of this Act at which
- 9 the voters of a municipality approved the creation of the venue
- 10 project and the levy of a two percent increase in the local hotel
- 11 occupancy tax; and
- 12 (2) the levy and collection of a two percent increase
- 13 in the local hotel occupancy tax for a venue project that occurred
- 14 before the effective date of this Act.
- 15 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
- 16 effective date of this Act:
- 17 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 18 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
- 19 judgment; or
- 20 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.
- 21 (c) This Act does not validate any governmental act or
- 22 proceeding that, under the law in effect at the time the act or
- 23 proceeding occurred, would constitute a criminal offense
- 24 punishable as a misdemeanor or felony.

- 1 SECTION 2. DISSOLUTION OF DISTRICTS IN CERTAIN COUNTIES
- 2 APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only to a district
- 3 wholly located in a county with a population of less than 15,000,
- 4 less than 2,800 square miles, and boarding the Pecos River.
- 5 DISSOLUTION. The governing body of each political
- 6 subdivision that created a district may dissolve the district by
- 7 adopting a concurrent order.
- 8 ASSETS AND LIABILITIES. (a) The assets and liabilities of a
- 9 district dissolved under this subchapter shall be transferred to
- 10 the county in which the district is located.
- 11 (b) After payment of district liabilities, the county shall
- 12 use the district assets that remain for an approved venue project of
- 13 the county.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
