- 7 District Local Laws Code, as effective April 1, 2011, is amended to

- 9 Sec. 1067.059. [APPOINTMENT AND RECRUITMENT OF] STAFF AND
- 10 EMPLOYEES.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1067.059, Special District Local Laws
- 12 Code, as effective April 1, 2011, is amended by amending Subsection
- 13 (b) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (d) to read as follows:
- 14 (b) The board may employ physicians, technicians, nurses,
- 15 other health care providers, and other employees as considered
- 16 necessary for the efficient operation of the hospital. Except as
- 17 provided by Subsection (b-1), the board [or] may provide that the
- 18 district administrator has the authority to admit or employ those
- 19 persons.
- 20 (b-1) The board may not delegate to the district
- 21 administrator the authority to employ physicians.
- 22 <u>(d) This section may not be construed as authorizing the</u>
- 23 board to supervise or control the practice of medicine, as
- 24 prohibited by Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
