5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 152, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Sections 152.1613 and 152.1614 to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 152.1613. MCLENNAN COUNTY JUVENILE BOARD LOCAL
9	ENRICHMENT PROGRAM. The McLennan County Juvenile Board may
10	establish and administer a local enrichment of juvenile services
11	program consistent with policies adopted by the juvenile board.
12	Sec. 152.1614. GIFT, GRANT, OR DONATION TO MCLENNAN COUNTY
13	JUVENILE BOARD. (a) The McLennan County Juvenile Board may accept a
14	gift, grant, or donation from a public or private source for any
15	lawful purpose, including support of a local enrichment of juvenile
16	services program.
17	(b) The juvenile board shall place a donation of money under
18	Subsection (a) in a special fund that is:
19	(1) subject to all reporting or procedural
20	requirements of the county auditor; and
21	(2) audited annually by the county auditor.
22	(c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the juvenile board is
23	not required to establish or adopt a budget for expenditures under
24	the special fund described by this section.

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H.B. No. 3829 (d) The special fund described by Subsection (b) may be used 1 2 only to pay expenses of and related to programs, services, and items approved by the juvenile board. 3 4 (e) An expenditure from the special fund described by Subsection (b) must comply with the requirements of Chapter 262, 5 6 Local Government Code, that apply to the juvenile board's other 7 expenditures. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8

9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
