- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 156.401(a), Family Code, is amended to

- 6 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1) or (b), the court
- 7 may modify an order that provides for the support of a child,
- 8 including an order for health care coverage under Section 154.182,

- 10 (1) the circumstances of the child or a person

- 14 (B) the date of the signing of a mediated or

- 17 (2) it has been  $\underline{\text{two}}$  [three] years since the order was
- 18 rendered or last modified and the monthly amount of the child
- 19 support award under the order differs by either 10 [20] percent or
- $20 \frac{$50}{}$  [\$100] from the amount that would be awarded in accordance with

- SECTION 2. Section 233.013(b), Family Code, is amended to

- 1 order was rendered or last modified and the amount of the child
- 2 support award under the order differs by either 10 [20] percent or

- 4 support guidelines, the Title IV-D agency shall file an appropriate
- 5 child support review order, including an order that has the effect

- 8 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 9 156.401, Family Code, applies only to a suit for modification
