H.B. No. 3850

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the application of the professional prosecutors law to
3 the county attorney of Oldham County and the district attorney for
4 the 287th Judicial District.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 45.280(b), Government Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 (b) The county attorney in Oldham County is entitled to be
9 compensated by the state in the manner and amount provided by
10 general law relating to the salary paid to a district judge
11 ~~[attorneys]~~ by the state as provided by Section 46.003, except
12 that ~~[and]~~ Oldham County shall pay \$28,500 of the county attorney's
13 total salary, and the state shall pay the remainder of the salary.

14 SECTION 2. Section 46.002, Government Code, is amended to
15 read as follows:

16 Sec. 46.002. PROSECUTORS SUBJECT TO CHAPTER. This chapter
17 applies to the state prosecuting attorney, all county prosecutors,
18 and the following state prosecutors:

5 (2) the criminal district attorneys for the counties
6 of Anderson, Austin, Bastrop, Bexar, Bowie, Brazoria, Caldwell,
7 Calhoun, Cass, Collin, Comal, Dallas, Deaf Smith, Denton, Eastland,
8 Fannin, Galveston, Grayson, Gregg, Harrison, Hays, Hidalgo,
9 Jasper, Jefferson, Kaufman, Lubbock, McLennan, Madison, Navarro,
10 Newton, Panola, Polk, Randall, Rockwall, San Jacinto, Smith,
11 Tarrant, Taylor, Tyler, Upshur, Van Zandt, Victoria, Walker,
12 Waller, Wichita, Wood, and Yoakum; and

13 (3) the county attorneys performing the duties of
14 district attorneys in the counties of Andrews, Callahan, Cameron,
15 Castro, Colorado, Crosby, Ellis, Falls, Freestone, Lamar, Lamb,
16 Lampasas, Lee, Limestone, Marion, Milam, Morris, Ochiltree,
17 Oldham, Orange, Rains, Red River, Robertson, Rusk, Swisher, Terry,
18 Webb, and Willacy.

19 SECTION 3. Section 45.280(c), Government Code, is repealed.

20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
