## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 3.0305(a), Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th
- 5 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The following wells are exempt from the requirements of
- 7 Chapter 36, Water Code, and may not be regulated, permitted, or
- 8 metered by the district:
- 9 (1) a well used for domestic use by a single private
- 10 residential household and producing not more [less] than 15,000
- 11  $\left[\frac{25,000}{}\right]$  gallons per day; and
- 12 (2) a well used for conventional farming and ranching
- 13 activities, including such intensive operations as aquaculture,
- 14 livestock feedlots, or poultry operations.
- SECTION 2. Section 3.0307, Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th
- 16 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended by amending
- 17 Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 18 (d) Permanent directors serve staggered <u>four-year</u>
- 19 [two-year] terms.
- 20 <u>(i) A director may not serve more than two consecutive</u>
- 21 four-year terms. A former director may serve a third or subsequent
- 22 term if that director has not served for four years. A former
- 23 director who has not served for four years may be appointed to fill
- 24 a vacancy on the board and, if elected, may serve two full terms

- 1 after the expiration of the term to fill the vacancy.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 3.0310, Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th
- 3 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3.0310. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. [<del>(a)</del>] On the uniform
- 5 <u>election date</u> [<u>first Saturday</u>] in May <u>of each even-numbered year</u>
- 6 [or the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of the
- 7 first even-numbered year after the year in which the district is
- 8 authorized to be created at a confirmation election], an election
- 9 shall be held in the district for the election of the appropriate
- 10 <u>number of</u> [three] directors [to serve two-year terms and two
- 11 directors to serve one-year terms].
- 12 [(b) On the first Saturday in May or the first Tuesday after
- 13 the first Monday in November, as applicable, of each subsequent
- 14 second year following the election held under Subsection (a) of
- 15 this section, the appropriate number of directors shall be
- 16 <del>elected.</del>]
- SECTION 4. Sections 3.0312(a) and (b), Chapter 966, Acts of
- 18 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are amended to read as
- 19 follows:
- 20 (a) Except as provided by Sections 3.0305(b) and (c) of this
- 21 part, the district may require a permit for the construction of a
- 22 new well completed after the effective date of this Act and may
- 23 charge and collect a construction permit fee not to exceed \$1,000
- 24 [<del>\$300</del>].
- 25 (b) The district may levy and collect a water utility
- 26 service connection fee not to exceed \$1,000 [\$300] for each new
- 27 water service connection made after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 This subsection does not apply to a water utility that has surface
- 2 water as its sole source of water.
- 3 SECTION 5. Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 4 Regular Session, 2001, is amended by adding Part 3A to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 PART 3A. CERTAIN POWERS OF THE HAYS TRINITY GROUNDWATER
- 7 <u>CONSERVATION DISTRICT</u>
- 8 Sec. 3A.0351. DEFINITIONS. In this part:
- 9 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the
- 10 <u>district.</u>
- 11 (2) "District" means the Hays Trinity Groundwater
- 12 Conservation District.
- Sec. 3A.0352. HIGH VOLUME WELLS. (a) In this section,
- 14 "high volume well" means a well that is capable of producing more
- 15 than 15,000 gallons per day for any use.
- 16 (b) An application for a permit to operate a high volume
- 17 well in the district must include:
- 18 (1) the name and mailing address of all persons who own
- 19 property within one-quarter mile of the well site; and
- 20 (2) proof that the owner or operator requesting the
- 21 permit has provided notice to all persons listed in Subdivision (1)
- 22 according to the form prescribed by the board.
- 23 SECTION 6. Sections 3.0304(d) and 3.0306(b), Chapter 966,
- 24 Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are repealed.
- 25 SECTION 7. Not later than three months after the effective
- 26 date of this Act, the board of directors of the Hays Trinity
- 27 Groundwater Conservation District shall adopt rules to implement

- 2 Session, 2001, as added by this Act.
- 3 SECTION 8. (a) Section 3.0310, Chapter 966, Acts of the
- 4 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, as amended by this Act,
- 5 applies only to a member of the board of directors of the Hays
- 6 Trinity Groundwater Conservation District elected on or after
- 7 September 1, 2011.
- 8 (b) A member of the board of directors of the Hays Trinity
- 9 Groundwater Conservation District elected in May 2010 serves a
- 10 two-year term.
- 11 (c) A member of the board of directors of the Hays Trinity
- 12 Groundwater Conservation District elected in May 2011 serves a
- 13 three-year term.
- 14 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
