## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the date for the election of directors of the Hill
- 3 Country Underground Water Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 8844.104, Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8844.104. ELECTION DATE. Each <u>even-numbered</u>
- 8 [odd-numbered] year, the board shall hold an election in the
- 9 district on the uniform election date in November [May] to elect the
- 10 appropriate number of directors.
- 11 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 8844.102, Special
- 12 District Local Laws Code:
- 13 (1) a member of the board of directors of the Hill
- 14 Country Underground Water Conservation District elected in May 2009
- 15 shall serve until the member's successor has qualified following
- 16 the directors' election held on the uniform election date in
- 17 November 2012 in accordance with Section 8844.104, Special District
- 18 Local Laws Code, as amended by this Act; and
- 19 (2) a member of the board of directors of the Hill
- 20 Country Underground Water Conservation District elected in May 2011
- 21 shall serve until the member's successor has qualified following
- 22 the directors' election held on the uniform election date in
- 23 November 2014 in accordance with Section 8844.104, Special District
- 24 Local Laws Code, as amended by this Act.

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- 1 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 2 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 3 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 4 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 5 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 6 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 7 Government Code.
- 8 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 9 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 10 Environmental Quality.
- 11 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 12 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 13 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 14 representatives within the required time.
- 15 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 16 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 17 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 18 and accomplished.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
