CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Regents School of Austin football team reached
2 the pinnacle of success by winning the Texas Association of Private
3 and Parochial Schools Division III state football championship for
4 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, In the title game held December 4, 2010, at Temple
6 Wildcat Stadium, the Knights put on an unstoppable display of
7 offensive firepower to defeat Bullard Brook Hill 38-7; with this
8 victory, Regents became the first school in the history of TAPPS to
9 garner five state football titles in one decade, having previously
10 won titles in six-man football in 2001, 2002, and 2003 and in 11-man
11 football in 2006; and

12 WHEREAS, Head coach Beck Brydon guided the Knights to an
13 overall record of 14 wins and 1 loss over the course of the 2010
14 season, and the squad outscored opponents 725 to 256; Coach
15 Brydon's efforts were supported by a strong coaching staff that
16 includes Clay Carter, Sam Thompson, Scott Franklin, Mike Lapaglia,
17 Landon Durham, Guy Grace, and Steve Chapman; and

18 WHEREAS, To bring home the state title, the Regents team
